

Q. Do I have to be a member of USA Hockey Inline?

A. Coaches and players must be current members of USA Hockey Inline. If they are not members, they can purchase a Weekend Warrior pass at registration for \$10.

Q. Can a player play "up" a division (e.g., an 11 year old play in a 14 and under division?)

A. Players may play up one age division. Girls are also allowed to play "down" one age division based on the USA Hockey Inline Rule. (e.g. an 11 year old girl is eligible to play in the 10 and under division, but a 12 year old girl must play in the 12 and under division). The one exception is addressed below.

Q. Can a player under 18 years old play on an adult team?

A. No. No one under 18 years old can play "up" on an adult team.

Q. Can a player play on more than one team if the teams are in different age divisions (e.g., a 10 year old play on a 10u team and a 12u team)?

A. Yes, players can play on up to two teams, but not more than two teams. The two teams cannot be in the same age division. For example, a player cannot play on a 12u gold and a 12u silver team. No special schedule accommodations will be made for players on two teams. If both teams play at the same time, game times will not be changed to accommodate the players or teams.

Q. Once a team is knocked out of the tournament, can I add a player from another team to my roster for the rest of the tournament?

A. No. A team's roster is final once they check-in at registration. Players playing on two teams must be listed on both rosters before the start of the tournament.

Q. How are players' ages determined?

A. Age classification will be determined by the age of players as of December 31, 2006, according to USA Hockey Inline rules for youth teams. For the Adult Division, age classification will be determined by the age of players as of September 24, 2007. Players must be 18 years of age by this date.

Q Do I have to wear a mouthpiece?

A. Yes. All players must wear a mouthpiece during play.

Q Do I have to have a mask on my helmet?

A. All players under 18 years old must have a mask on their helmet.

Q. How long are the games?

A. Each game will have three 10-minute periods, running time. Stop clock last 2 minutes with a 2 goal differential.

Q. How are ties broken in bracket play?

A. The top teams in each division will advance. Tiebreakers are as follows - head to head, goals against, goals for, least amount of penalty minutes, and shoot-out.

Q. How many players and coaches can a team have?

A. Each team is allowed a maximum of 14 players and 3 coaches. There are no exceptions.
