Final Race Instructions Mickey's Halloween 5K

PACKET PICK-UP



You are required to attend Packet Pick-Up to receive your event shirt, race number, goody bag, Mickey's Not So Scary Halloween Party ticket, and sign your waiver. You must bring your Photo ID to Packet Pick-Up. Packet Pick-Up is on Friday, Oct. 1, 2010 from Noon – 8:00 p.m. at the *Jostens*®

Center at ESPN Wide World of Sports Complex. Please remember that strollers are not permitted inside the *Jostens*® Center. There will be a stroller parking area available outside the *Jostens*® Center where you can leave your stroller during Packet Pick-Up. For those who cannot attend Packet Pick-Up on Friday, late Packet Pick-Up will be available on race morning from 5:45 a.m. – 6:45 a.m. at the Box Office at the Transportation and Ticket Center near *Magic Kingdom*® Park. Please remember to bring your Photo ID.

WAIVERS & ABSENTEE PACKET PICK-UP

A waiver must be completed and signed by each participant. If the participant is under 18 years old, the waiver must be completed and signed by a parent or legal guardian.

If you are unable to attend Packet Pick-Up, the individual picking up on your behalf must provide the following items as well as his/her Photo ID:

- 1. A copy of your driver's license or Photo ID
- 2. Your signed waiver
- 3. Your signed Packet Pick-Up Authorization Form

The Packet Pick-Up Authorization Form and waiver will be available on the web site. It is important that you download these forms and bring them with you to the Disney Wine & Dine Half Marathon Expo.

COMMEMORATIVE PIN PICK UP

Pre-ordered commemorative pins will be distributed when you pick up your race packet. Please remember that commemorative pins not picked up will not be mailed or refunded. A limited number of pins may be available for purchase at the Merchandise locations at the Health & Fitness Expo.

RACE INFORMATION

RACE START

The race will start promptly at 7:00 a.m. on Saturday, Oct. 2 on Topiary Lane at the Transportation and Ticket Center near *Magic Kingdom*® Park. Please plan to arrive by 6:15 a.m. If participating in a racing wheelchair, please line up in front of the runners for a 6:59 a.m. start time. This start is only for those participants who are participating in a racing wheelchair. If participating in a non-racing/PushRim wheelchair,

please line up with the walking group at the end of the start line chute. Your start time will be with the rest of the field at 7:00 a.m.

TIMING, RACE RESULTS AND AWARDS

This 5K is a non-timed fun run. No race results will be posted and awards will not be given out. Every finisher will receive a finisher medallion. Please note there is a 16-minute per mile time limit. Anyone not able to maintain that pace may be picked up and transported to the finish line area.

PACE GROUPS

Please note that pacing signs will be placed in the start line chute. Please be courteous to your fellow participants and line up in the correct pace group for your personal pace. The pace groups are as follows: (time is per mile)

7:00 minutes and under
7:01-9:00 minutes
9:01-11:00 minutes
11:01-13:00 minutes
13:01-15:00 minutes
Walkers & Non-racing Wheelchair Participants

BIB NUMBERS

Each participant will be issued a bib number at Packet Pick-Up. Please wear the bib number centered on the front of your shirt. Participants without a bib number will be removed from the course for security and safety reasons. Please remember to fill out the Emergency Medical Information on the back of the bib number. Safety pins for the bib numbers will be in your Goody Bag.

BAG CHECK

Bag Check will be located on Topiary Lane at the Transportation and Ticket Center near *Magic Kingdom*® Park. Bag Check will be open from 5:45 a.m. until 9:00 a.m. You will receive a clear plastic bag at Packet Pick-Up, please use this bag for the bag check service. We will not accept any other type of bag. You will also receive a numbered bag check sticker in your race packet. Please attach the sticker to the clear plastic bag prior to arriving at Bag Check. You should place the sticker in the clearly defined area on your clear plastic bag. Once you finish, your race number will be used to verify your bag when you pick it up. Please do not check any valuable items. The Event Staff is not responsible for any lost, damaged, or stolen items. Any bags not picked up by 9:00 a.m. will be taken to Lost and Found at the ESPN Wide World of Sports Complex.

SAFETY REMINDERS

All participants should be able to complete the race under their own power. For everyone's safety, baby joggers/strollers, baby carriers, baby backpacks, bicycles, motorized scooters, inline skates, skateboards, walking sticks, walkers, and animals of any kind are prohibited on the course. If you are seen in violation of one of these restrictions, you will be removed from the course and transported to the finish line area.

Headphones are discouraged due to audio messages that are placed throughout the course to ensure your safety.

COSTUMES

You are allowed to wear a costume when participating in this 5K. However, your costume cannot include a face mask. Anyone seen in violation of this will be removed from the course. If your costume is questionable or offensive to others, we reserve the right to have you change into something more appropriate or remove you from the event completely.

WEATHER

The race will be held rain or shine. If there is lightning in the area, the race will either have a delayed start or depending on the intensity of the weather, be cancelled. The determination will be made by the Event Management staff.

The Walt Disney World® Resort Lightning Policy is as follows:

Event operations will shut down when lightning is 10 miles out from the event areas. Event operations will not resume until the lightning is 10 miles out and moving away from the event areas. The *Flash to Bang Rule* and weather radar will be used to determine this. The Sports Manager will consult with the Theme Park Partners and *Walt Disney World*® Security on a course of action to utilize the operational rain plan, delay the event, or cancel the event.

Flash to Bang Rule is applied by measuring the time (in seconds) between a visual lightning "Flash" and hearing the resulting "Bang". This time is then divided by a factor of "5" to obtain distance in miles. For example, 50 seconds between "Flash" and "Bang" divided by "5" equals 10 miles.

As a reminder, the registration fees are non-refundable and non-transferable.

PHOTOGRAPHERS

ASI photographers will be on the course and at the finish line taking pictures of you during the race. Please wear your bib number on the front of your shirt. Please visit asiorders.com after the race to view your photos. Photos usually take 2-3 days to be loaded onto the website. You will need your race number to access your photos.

COURSE

COURSE DESCRIPTION

Race toward Magic Kingdom® Park from Topiary Lane, run down Main Street, U.S.A.® toward Adventureland® where you will run past The Magic Carpets of Aladdin, Jungle Cruise, and the Pirates of the Caribbean attractions while racing towards Frontierland®. Once in Frontierland®, you will run past Splash Mountain® and through Liberty Square. You'll pass by Cinderella Castle, the Mad Tea Party, and the Tomorrowland® Indy

Speedway. Once in *Tomorrowland*®, you'll run by *Space Mountain*®, and then you are on your way to the finish passing *Disney's Contemporary Resort* and back to Topiary Lane at the Transportation and Ticket Center.

WATER AND MEDICAL STOPS

There will be two water stops along the course (Mile .75 and Mile 2) and medical personnel on bikes will ride along with you. There will be a medical area at the finish line.

SPECTATOR VIEWING

Spectators can view the 5K Start/Finish on Topiary Lane. There are no viewing locations along the course or from within the *Magic Kingdom*® Park.

RACE DAY HOST RESORT TRANSPORTATION

Bus transportation is provided for this event if you are staying at one of the host resorts listed below

*Participants staying at *Disney's Polynesian* Resort will be able to walk to the 5K race site, therefore transportation to the 5K race start will NOT be provided from *Disney's Polynesian* Resort. Please follow the signs along the walkway to the Transportation and Ticket Center when exiting the main entrance of *Disney's Polynesian* Resort.*

Please check with the front desk when you check-in and they will provide you with a Times Guide including more detailed information on weekend transportation, Expo Hours, etc. Transportation will run from 5:00-6:00 a.m. prior to the race. The last bus from the host resorts to the *Magic Kingdom*® Park will depart at 6:00 a.m. Buses will run until 9:00 a.m. after the race to return you to one of the host resorts. There is no monorail service to the start of this race.

Parking at the *Magic Kingdom*® Park is complimentary before 7:00 a.m. If you arrive after 7:00 a.m., you will be charged the daily parking fee.

All participants must arrive at the Transportation and Ticket Center near Magic Kingdom® Park by 6:15 a.m.
